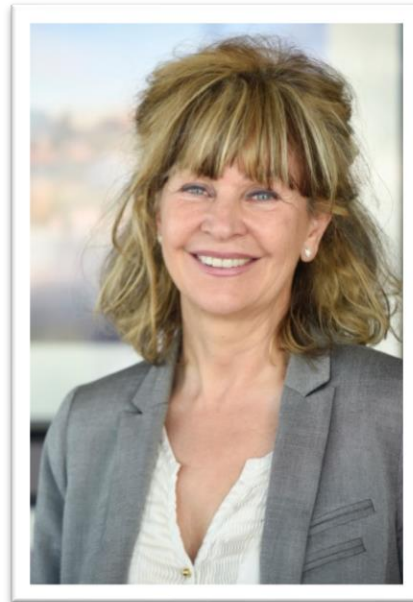

Engineer graduated from *Ecole des Mines* of Alès, France, Claire-Anne REIX started her career as manager of satellite facilities at *Aérospatiale*. Responsible for manufacturing, integration, tests and quality activities, telecommunications, space exploration/observation satellites, successively at *Alcatel Space* and *Thales Alenia Space*. In 2005, Claire-Anne Reix has been named *GMES/Copernicus Corporate Director*. In 2018, she has been appointed as *Copernicus data and services exploitation Director* at *Thales Alenia Space*. In parallel, she took over the Chairmanship of *SAFE*, the French cluster in charge of security, safety, environment, as well as aerospace. Claire-Anne Reix has also been nominated as auditor of *INHESJ* (National Institute for advanced security and justice studies), a public institution under the Prime Minister's supervision. Since 2014, Claire-Anne Reix is city councilor of *Cannes*, in charge of risk management, tourism, international development, congresses and events. The same year, she's been named Chairman of the board of the *Palais des Festivals et des Congrès de Cannes*.
